
HOW TO APPLY

Submit your completed application to PhORCAS by **January 8, 2021**:

- **Letter of Intent:** specify dates you are available for interview in January and February
- **Current curriculum vitae**
- **Completed Pre-Residency Self-Assessment:** limit to 3-5 pages, upload as supplemental material
- **Documentation of United States Citizenship:** upload scanned passport photo page, naturalization papers, or birth certificate
- **Official college of pharmacy transcript,** along with any other college transcripts
- **Three recommendation letters:** use PhORCAS Standard Applicant Recommendation Request form, no supplemental letters, at least two should be from clinical preceptors

Deadline remains firm for the materials submitted by applicant. Letters of recommendation and transcripts received past the third Friday in January will not be accepted.

Submit all your materials through PhORCAS. **We will not accept any materials sent directly to the hospital.** You will be able to track the progress of your application through PhORCAS.
